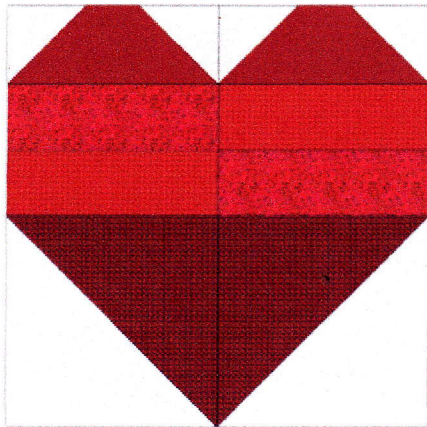


# Block of the Month – February

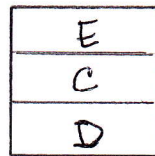
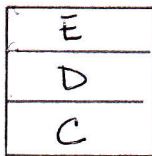
## HEART

Block Size -- 8" x 8" finished (8½" x 8½" with seam allowance)



	<b>Fabric:</b>	<b>Cut Directions:</b>
A	White Tone-on-tone print	(1) -- 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" (4) -- 2" x 2"
B	Red Print	(1) -- 4 7/8" x 4 7/8"
C	Red Print	(2) -- 4½" x 1 3/4"
D	Red Print	(2) -- 4½" x 1 3/4"
E	Red Print	(2) -- 4½" x 2"

Step 1: Sew together the two 4½" x 1 3/4" red prints (print C and print D) and the 4½" x 2" red print (print E), keeping print E at the top, making 4½" square units. Note that the order of one unit (top to bottom) is Print E, Print D, and Print C and the order of the second unit (top to bottom) is Print E, Print C, and Print D.



Step 2: With right sides together, pin one small white square to the corner of the red stripe units (white square should be on top of print E), draw a diagonal line from opposite corners, and stitch on that line. Cut ¼" from the stitched line that is towards the outside corner. Looking at the sample, do the same for the other corner of the same red rectangle. (Unit 1)
