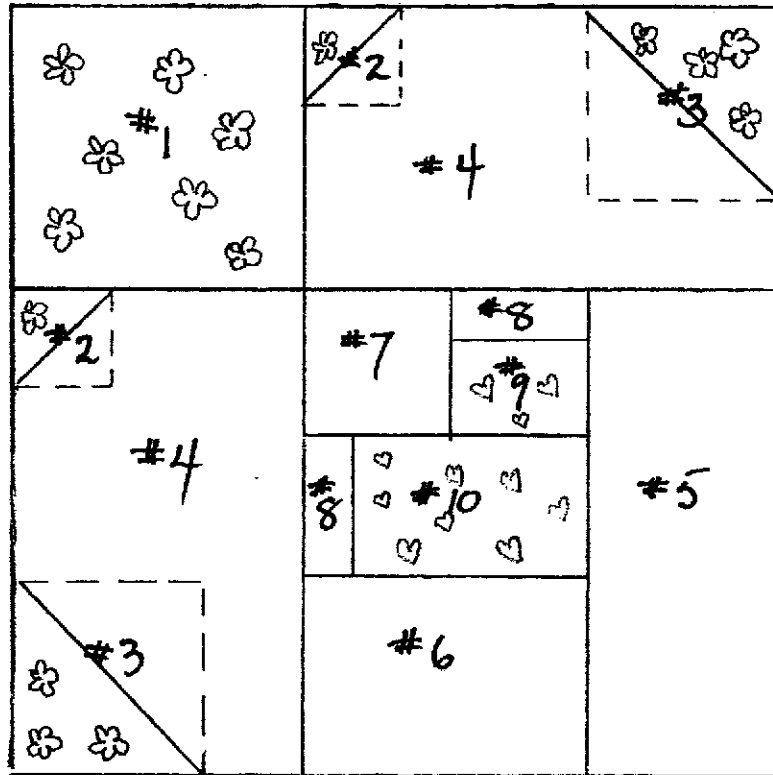


# BLOCK OF THE MONTH - FEBRUARY, 2018



**FROM BACKGROUND FABRIC, CUT:**

Piece #1 - 1 @ 3-1/2" square

Piece #2 - 2 @ 1-1/2" square

Piece #3 - 2 @ 2-1/2" square

**FROM MAIN HEART FABRIC, CUT:**

Piece #4 - 2 @ 5-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Piece #5 - 1 @ 5-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Piece #6 - 1 @ 3-1/2" X 2-1/2"

Piece #7 - 1 @ 2" x 2"

Piece #8 - 2 @ 2" x 1"

**FROM INNER HEART FABRIC, CUT:**

Piece #9 - 1 @ 2" x 1-1/2"

Piece #10 - 1 @ 2" x 3"

Mark diagonal lines on the wrong side of pieces #2 and #3 and sew, right sides together, on pieces #4 as shown on diagram. Press and trim off excess.

Sew piece #1 to upper piece #4.

Sew Inner Heart section: sew piece #8 to #9; sew that resulting unit to piece #7. Sew piece #8 to #10 and sew that resulting unit to the piece #7/8/9 unit.

Sew completed Inner Heart unit to piece #6, then that resulting unit to piece #5 and the remaining (vertical) piece #4. Then sew it all together.

Hopefully your resulting block measures 8-1/2" square.

NOTE: If you enjoy applique, PLEASE feel free to position a heart shape diagonally on a 3-1/2" square of main heart fabric and then sew to piece #6, etc.
