

CVQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH for APRIL, 2018

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

24 @ 2-1/2" squares, assorted

4 @ 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" beige, off/white or other neutral

4 @ 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" beige, off/white or other neutral

ASSEMBLY:

Construct a 16-patch using the assorted 2-1/2" squares.

(4 rows of 4 squares each). Now would be a good time to make sure that you have a square measuring 8-1/2", and if it's too large because your seam allowances were a bit too small, you can trim an equal amount off all sides to make it measure 8-1/2" square.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the remaining eight 2-1/2" squares. Place one square on the end of each of the neutral rectangles; sew on the diagonal and trim. Sew two of the 4-1/2" rectangles together at the "points" and two of the 6-1/2" rectangles together at the "points". NOTE: when sewing the diagonals make sure that half of the points face in one direction and half in the other.

Sew each of the 8-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of the 16-patch, and then 12-1/2" rectangles to the sides.

You should now have a 12-1/2" square ready to turn in.
