

February Instructions for the CVQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH
To be turned in on March 14, 2020

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - CUT

Color A - 4 @ 2-1/2" square

Color B - 4 @ 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" AND 2 @ 2-1/2" square

Color C - 2 @ 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" AND 2 @ 2-1/2" square

ASSEMBLY:

Make a 4-patch unit from 2 each of the A and B 2-1/2" squares.

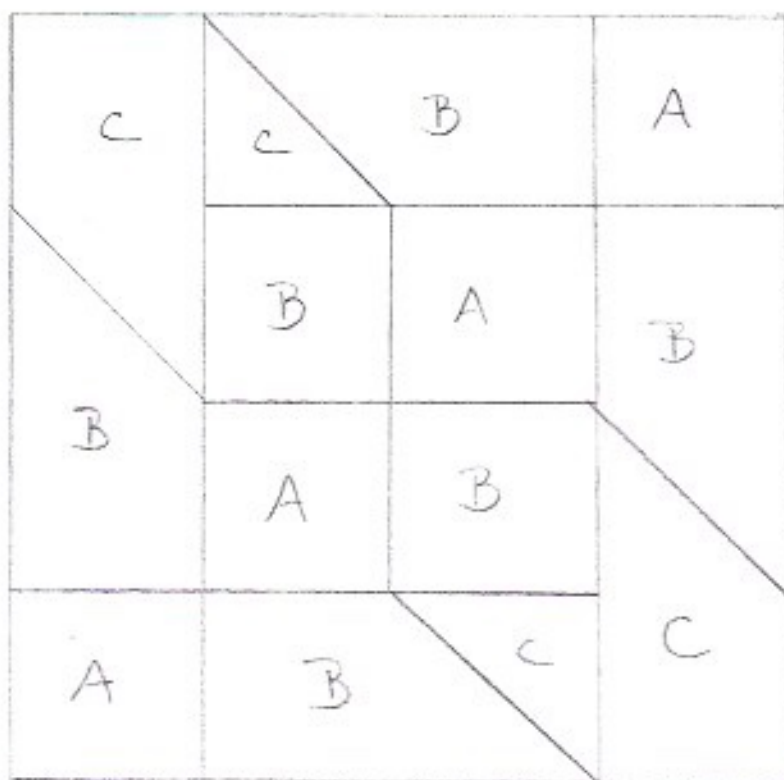
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 color C squares. Place at one end of two of the color B rectangles. Sew on the diagonal and trim away the excess.

MAKE SURE you have the "points" going the correct direction. Repeat. Join one of the resulting pieces to the top and one to the bottom of the 4-patch unit.

On the wrong side, mark a point 2-1/2" from the end of a color B rectangle and then draw a diagonal line from that point to the corner. Place that piece, right sides together, on top of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" color C rectangle (as if you were joining two pieces of binding together),* sew on the line and trim away the excess. Again, MAKE SURE you have the "points" going in the correct direction. Repeat. Add a color A square to the color B end of each of the newly created 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.

Sew the three units together.

You should have an 8-1/2" square block to turn in.



Do it this way for the correct point direction
