

CVQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH for OCTOBER, 2019

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Center (1): Cut 1 @ 2" square

Flower (2): Cut 4 @ 2" square

Leaf (3): Cut 4 @ 2" x 3-1/2" AND 4 @ 2" x 5"

Background(Sky) (4): Cut 12 @ 2" square;

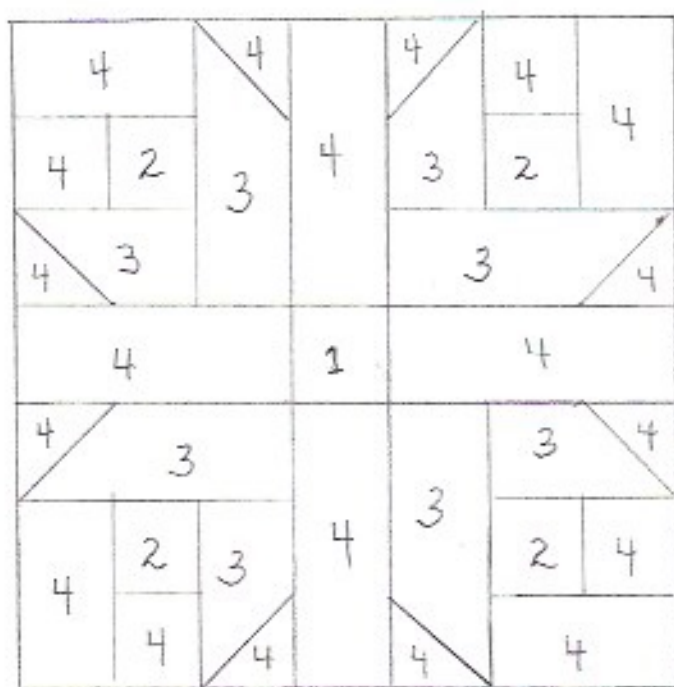
4 @ 2" x 3-1/2" AND 4 @ 2" x 5"

ASSEMBLY:

Make 4 of the corner blocks as shown on the enlargement, as follows: Sew the flower square to a background square. Then add the 2"x3.5" rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the remaining 2" background squares and sew them on one end of each of the leaf rectangles, making sure you have the points going in the correct direction. Cut off the excess. Sew the shorter rectangle to the flower block; then add the longer rectangle.

Sew a 5" background piece between two of the corner units. Repeat. Sew the center square between the two remaining 5" background rectangles. Then sew the three "rows" together

You should have a 11" block to turn in.
