

Although this is not the same pattern it is interesting in that it uses only blue prints.

It is successful because the fabrics are divided into lights and darks with lights as background and darks for weave.



This version uses Kaffe Fassett woven stripes cut perpendicular to the stripe with denim sashing.



This quilt is made with solids on a white background. Yellow, Green and Blue are neighbors on the color wheel. White and gray are neutrals.

Approximate Fabric Requirements

Pattern Size (twin)

- 72" x 96"
- 48 -12.5" blocks
 - 6 blocks per row with 8 rows
- 80 WOF strips or about 5 5/8 yds.
- 2 3/8 yds background

Throw

- 60" x 72"
- 30 12.5" blocks
 - 5 blocks per row with 6 rows
- 50 WOF strips or about 3.5 yds.
- 1.5 yds background

Baby

- 48" x 48"
- 16 12.5" blocks
 - 4 blocks per row with 4 rows
- 27 WOF strips or about 2 yds.
- 1 yd background

How many Strips?

Full Size


- 48 blocks
- 48 12.5"
- 96 11"
- 96 9.5"
- 48 8"

Throw

- 30 Blocks
- 30 12.5"
- 60 11"
- 60 9.5"
- 30 8"

Baby

- 16 blocks
- 16 12.5"
- 32-11"
- 32 9.5"
- 16 8"



Tips







- **Do a Test Block** to check your ¼" seam and understand pattern
- Double Check measurements (2.25" on left and 1.5" on right) before cutting through block
- Make sure your perpendicular seams visually line up.
- Make sure you have a variety of color / pattern in each block.

Tips

Check ¼" Seam



Doublecheck 2.25" on left and 1.5" on right before cutting



Make sure perpendicular seams visually line up.
