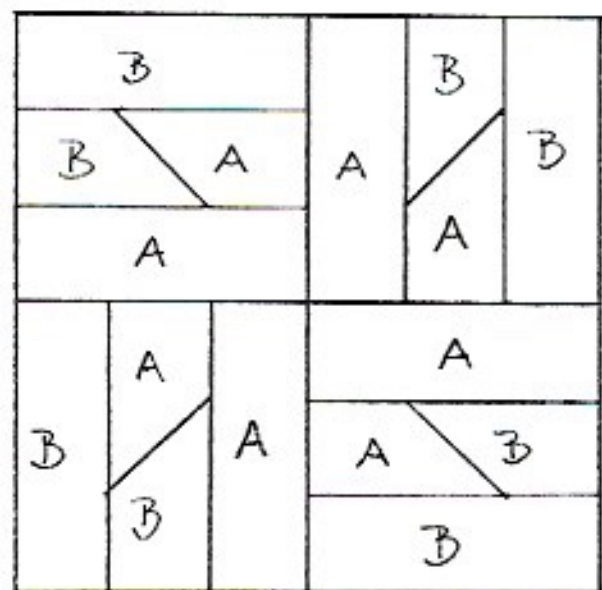


CVQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Instructions - PROVIDED AT JANUARY 2023 MEETING

Color Choices: Either a light blue background ("B") and a dark contrast for the starburst ("A") or a dark background with a light starburst.

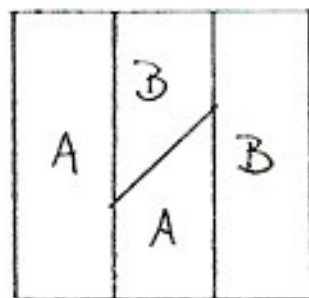


Fabric Requirements:
For Both A and B, cut:
4 @ $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ and
4 @ $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$

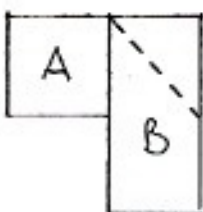
Hint: Take care to get all the diagonal slants going the correct way.

Construction - Make 4 of these units:

For the "point" piece, place a background "B" $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle right side down on top of a $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ color A (right side facing up), as shown below. Mark diagonal line; sew and trim away excess.

Sew this "point" piece between an A and a B $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle.

Sew the 4 units together as per the diagram.

You should have a $12\frac{1}{2}''$ block to turn in.
