Coachella Valley Quilt Guld Block of the Month – March 2024

Fabric A - Cut one 10" x 10" square


Fabric B - Cut one 10" x 10" square

Fabric C – Cut two 2" x 9 ½ " rectangles

Cut two 2" x 12 ½ " rectangles


Directions:

Place A and B, right sides together. Mark the back of either A or B with a line from one corner to the opposite diagonal corner.



Sew a scant 1/4" seam on both sides of the straigth line just drawn. See the dotted lines. Cut on the solid line, so that you have two 9 ½" squares, made up of fabic A and fabric B.

Add Fabric C $-2" \times 9 \%"$ rectangles to each side of the A/B block. Then add Fabric C $-2" \times 12 \%"$ rectangles to the top and the bottom of the block. Square to 12 %".
