



## Fabulous Faces

### Materials

Plan on making 2 to 3 portraits in a day.

- Background fabrics to make your Portraits on (*fat quarters work well*)
- Scraps and fat quarters to use to “paint” your face and features, Plan on using lots of different fabrics.
- Novelty fabrics (notice the bugs and bottles used for their hair?) Fabrics for fussy cutting: do you have anything that might look like an eye? A round or oval shape? Peacock feathers? Bring all your scraps with you.
- Basic Sewing and cutting supplies including scissors and pins.
- Glue Stick! Very important – you may need several large ones – I prefer **Elmer’s Washable School Glue Sticks**; the glue stick material is a purple color. You can buy these at office supply stores.
- Quilting and finishing techniques will be demonstrated in class, most students prefer to make several portraits and quilt at home. This is your option. If you wish to sew, include the list below in your supplies.

### **OPTIONAL:**

- **50W Aurifil** cotton thread. Color? Bring several options, neutral, skin and a few bolder colors.
- **YLI 40W** black cotton thread for “sketchy quilting” aka outlining the portrait.
- Sewing machine with your free motion or darning foot.
- Batting and your backing fabric
