





CVQG Block of the Month – November 2024

Fabric A – Light. Cut (4) 2 ½” by 2 ½” squares and cut (1) 5” square

Fabric B – Medium. Cut (4) 2 ½” by 2 ½” squares

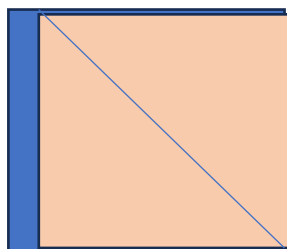
Fabric C – Medium. Cut (4) 2 ½” by 2 ½” squares

Fabric D – Dark. Cut (1) 5” square

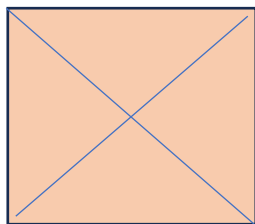
1. Place the 5” **A** fabric right sides together (RST) with 5” **D** fabric.



2. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the square facing up.

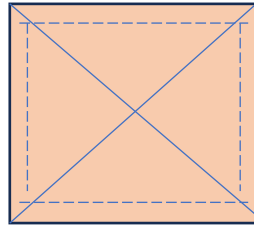


3. Draw a second diagonal line so that the two diagonal lines cross each other.

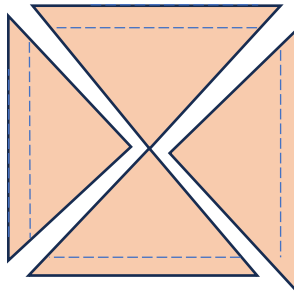

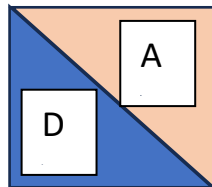
4. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around the perimeter of the block.



5. Cut the sewn fabrics on the original diagonal lines. This results in (4) half-square triangles (HST) composed of **A** and **D**.



6. Trim the HST to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



7. Using the layout guide shown above, sew the squares and half-square triangles together.
8. The block submitted will measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " by $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".
9. The finished quilt block will measure 8" by 8".
